

Dear Mason Adjunct Faculty Member:

Parking Services is sending this email as a follow up to the one sent by President Cabrera. The University has decided to further aid you when paying for parking and will be further subsidizing the cost of the discounted adjunct validation blocks and permits. As an adjunct faculty/staff member you have the full range of faculty/staff parking permits available to you. Should you wish to obtain parking at a lower cost, there are a few options only available to adjunct faculty. These discounted options will be available starting on Thursday, December 17<sup>th</sup> when Spring permits go on sale:

1. \*A block of 15 all-day validations for Mason Pond or Shenandoah Decks, or Founders Hall Garage at the Arlington Campus at 75% off (\$56). Some departments may pay for adjunct faculty validations. Please check your department for information. You are eligible for up to 4 blocks of validations per semester.
2. \*A Rappahannock River Deck validation code good for 15 uses (\$56).
3. An Adjunct General Lite Permit which allows you to park in Lots K, M, O, and P (\$52.50 for the semester permit). This permit is also valid at the Science and Technology Campus. It can be purchased online at [parking.gmu.edu](http://parking.gmu.edu) and printed up at home or the office. No request needs to be made for this type of permit. Once printed just display the permit on your dashboard when you come to campus.
