

President Cabrera announced that all adjunct faculty and non-student wage workers would receive a 50% discount on select parking permits for the 2017 Spring & Fall semesters as part of the Mason Strategic Retention initiative.

FAQ

Q - What does that mean?

A - Parking & Transportation will offer a semester version of the Lot M & P parking permit at \$62.50 and the West Campus parking permit at \$42.50. These permits are half the price of a regular permit for these options. These discounted parking permits will initially be offered as a hangtag purchased at the Parking Services office on the Fairfax campus. Q - When will these permits be available?

A - December 1, 2016 for the 2017 Spring semester.

Q - What if I already purchased a Lot M&P Annual permit or a West Campus Annual permit? Can I return my permit for a refund?

A - You can return your permit for a partial refund and then apply that towards the purchase of these discounted passes. If you wish to see what your refund would be please use the link below to look up our refund schedule. We are currently in the October 5th - January 17th date range.

Q - I work at the SciTech Campus? Is there a special rate for me? What if I work at the Arlington Campus?

A - Parking & Transportation will offer a semester version of a SciTech General Lot semester permit for \$117.50. This pass will only be valid at the SciTech Campus. We will also offer an Arlington General semester permit valid in the Metropolitan Garage for \$125. These rates are half off what the regular semester rates are for these campuses.

Q - Will anything be mailed to me?

A - No. You can purchase a discounted parking permit in person at the Parking Services office located next to the Shenandoah Parking Deck (building #44 on the campus map). Please park in the level 1 visitor section of the Shenandoah Parking Deck where the first 30 minutes is complimentary.

Q - Can I transfer these permits between vehicles?

A - Yes. Your discounted parking permit will be valid in any vehicle you drive.

Q - My parking permit was damaged or lost. How do I get a replacement?

A - If your permit was damaged or lost you need to obtain a replacement. Please come to the Parking Services office located next to the Shenandoah Parking Deck. There is a replacement fee on hangtags of \$15.00.

Q - My car is in the shop and I left my parking permit in the car. Now what?

A - Please come to the Parking Services office located next to the Shenandoah Parking Deck to obtain a temporary replacement.

Q - As an adjunct faculty member am I eligible to purchase these permits?

A - Yes. The new Lot M & P and West Campus semester permits are available to you as well. You still also have the current options, which are already discounted by 50%, for adjunct faculty members including a block of 15 discounted validations for the Mason Pond or Shenandoah Parking Decks; a discounted 15 time use code for the Rappahannock River Parking Deck; the Adjunct Lite annual discounted parking permit; or the Adjunct Lite semester discounted parking permit.
