

**Parking permits for the 2016 Summer Semester will go on sale starting on Monday, May 2nd, 2016 ONLINE ONLY.**

**For those purchasing permits with cash or Mason Money in person, permit sales begin May 2nd. Any permits purchased “in person” will still be fulfilled by mail.** We will have a limited number of General Lot permits; Mason Pond, Shenandoah, and Rappahannock River Parking Deck reserved permits; Lot J and Lot I reserved permits; and Arlington General permits available on a first come, first served basis.

### **How do I purchase my parking permit?**

- Go to [parking.gmu.edu](http://parking.gmu.edu) and click on Purchase Your Permit
- Log in using your Mason ID and password then click Purchase your Permit
- Verify and/or edit your mailing address
- Select the permit you would like to purchase
- Read all rules and regulations and verify permit type
- Verify all information before inputting payment information
- Click on the “print permit” link just below the permit description on the final screen. This will allow you to print a ten day temporary permit usable immediately while you’re waiting for the permit to arrive in the mail.

Parking Deck permits require an access device that will allow you to enter/exit the reserved areas of the parking deck (if you are purchasing the same Parking Deck reserved parking permit for the 2015-2016 academic year your current access device will be reactivated). If you will need to obtain one of these access devices please visit the appropriate Parking Services Office (Fairfax office is located next to the Shenandoah Parking Deck and is open Monday - Thursday, 8:30am-7pm and Friday from 8:30am-5pm. Arlington office is located in Room 219 of the Founders Hall Building and is open Monday – Thursday, 8:30am-6pm and Friday from 8:30am-3pm). Please allow 2 business days to obtain access device after permit purchase.

- Fairfax Resident/Prince William Beacon Hall permits: \$135
- Arlington General (Metropolitan Garage) permits: \$135
- Lot I Reserved and Rappahannock River Parking Deck Reserved permits: \$160
- Lot J Reserved permits: \$150
- Lot R Reserved permits: \$170
- Rappahannock River Deck Rooftop Only (Faculty/Staff Only) permits: \$145.
- Founders Hall Garage permits: \$160
- Mason Pond Parking Deck permits: \$205
- Shenandoah Parking Deck permits: \$205
- Mason Global Center Student permits: \$135
- Mason Global Center Faculty/Staff permits: \$120
- Motorcycle General Lot permits: \$30
- Motorcycle Deck permits: \$80

### **Summer Intern Parking:**

First and foremost welcome to Mason. Parking permits will be available online for purchase on Monday, May 9th. They are good for Lot R and are subject to all Lot R rules and regulations (<http://parking.gmu.edu/PDF2016Rules/LotRRulesRegulations2016.pdf>). These permits are valid from May 15<sup>th</sup> to August 15<sup>th</sup> and are \$170.00. - The Burke Center VRE has a **FREE PARKING GARAGE**. The Burke Centre VRE shuttle travels between the garage and Sandy Creek shuttle stop, the trip is approximately 15 minutes. Please check the shuttle schedule for full details.

### **Motorcycles, Mopeds, and Motorized Scooters:**

All motorcycles, mopeds and motorized scooters will be required to have a permit displayed when parking on any of George Mason University's campuses. Motorcycles, mopeds and motorized scooters will no longer be allowed to park at bike racks/shelters. Parking will only be permitted in dedicated motorcycle parking areas with a motorcycle permit, or in a regular vehicle space with a valid parking permit (lockable permit holders can be purchased at the Fairfax Parking Services Office for \$25). A dedicated motorcycle/moped/scooter permit can be purchased online for \$30/year, or \$30 as a supplemental permit when purchased with a regular vehicle permit. If you have a moped or motorized scooter that has not been registered with the DMV (no license plates), then you will need to purchase your permit at the Parking Services Office.

**Payroll Deduction Parking Permits - if you are currently on Payroll Deduction, there is nothing further that you need to do**

**Annual Parking Permits – If you have already purchased an Annual Permit there is nothing further that you need to do.**
