

Dear Resident Students:

With the forecast for heavy snow as early as Friday morning and continuing through the weekend, all students are required to move their vehicles from surface parking lots starting at 10:30pm Thursday. The visitor levels in the Mason Pond Deck (Levels 1 & 2 with entrances on Mason Pond Drive and Aquia Creek Lane) and the visitor level in the Shenandoah Deck (Level 1 with the entrance on Sandy Creek Way) will be opened at 10:30pm Thursday. Overnight restrictions in the General permit area of Rappahannock River Deck (Levels 1 & 2 with the exception of the visitor area which has a separate entrance and is also located on Level 1) will be waived Thursday evening. Other areas in these three parking decks may be opened Friday depending on the University's operating status.

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM SURFACE LOTS NO LATER THAN NOON ON FRIDAY OR ARE SUBJECT TO BEING TICKETED AND TOWED AT OWNER'S RISK & EXPENSE.

PLEASE DO NOT MOVE YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE GARAGES EARLIER THAN 10:30PM THURSDAY SO WE MAY ACCOMMODATE NORMAL ACADEMIC AND EVENT ACTIVITIES.

Information regarding the University's operating status on Friday and the weekend will be made by the Administration and sent out via Mason Alert. Regarding shuttle service, information will be provided as well based on the operating status. As a general rule of thumb, if Mason closes early, last departures are one hour after closing. If the University is closed, there is usually no shuttle service.
