

## FACULTY/STAFF 2017-18 PARKING PERMIT SALES & PAYROLL DEDUCTION RENEWAL INFORMATION

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THOSE WITH PAYROLL DEDUCTION PERMITS (PRFF, PRD1, PRD2, PRD3, PRAF, PRFH) do not have to do anything as their permits will auto-renew September 1. Faculty/Staff members who have other types of permits with Payroll Deduction will be contacted by Parking Services about renewing their payroll deduction for the same type of permit. If you are not contacted by Parking Services, please come to the Parking Services Office before your permit expires so we can arrange a renewal.**

**Parking permits for the 2017-2018 school year will go on sale starting on Monday, July 24, 2017 ONLINE ONLY.** For those purchasing parking permits with Mason Money or cash in person, permit sales begin August 7, 2017. **Any permits purchased "in person" will still be fulfilled by mail.** An exception to these rules will be made for any customers purchasing a sticker version of the General Lot Permit as that permit is not available online. We will have a limited number of reserved Mason Pond, Shenandoah, Rappahannock River, Founders Hall, Lot I, Lot J, Lot R parking permits and Arlington General permits available online on a first come, first served basis.
