

There are several large weeknight events coming up at EagleBank Arena that will have parking and traffic impacts on the Fairfax Campus:

- Wednesday, January 31 at 7 p.m. - Men's Basketball vs St. Bonaventure's. Doors open at 6 p.m.
- Wednesday, February 14 at 7 p.m. - Men's Basketball vs Dayton. Doors open at 6 p.m.
- Thursday, February 15 at 7 p.m. - Brantley Gilbert Concert. Doors open at 6 p.m.

For each of these, it is highly recommended to:

- Allow extra time commuting to and from campus.
- Avoid the southern end of campus off Braddock Road near EagleBank Arena.
- Expect event traffic for up to 2 hours before the doors open.
- Expect traffic delays on Mason Shuttles routes.
- Allow extra time for commuting.
- Shenandoah Deck Levels 4/5 will be open as overflow, general, and event parking on each of these event nights beginning at 5 p.m.
- Parking in Rappahannock River Parking Deck is strongly suggested to avoid the Arena parking and traffic impacts.

Campus Drive

On Tuesday, January 30, there will be alternating lane closures on Campus Drive at Global Lane. Expect delays along Campus Drive.

In addition, for the next six to eight weeks, Fairfax Water will close one of two right-turn lanes from Campus Drive onto Braddock Road, and one westbound lane on Braddock Road, as the water transmission line project continues toward Shirley Gate Road. There may be other temporary lane closures along Campus Drive for those leaving campus before 4 p.m.

Lane closures will occur Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Expect delays if leaving campus via Campus Drive or Braddock Road.
