

## World Police & Fire Games at George Mason University Fairfax Campus June 26-July 5

Fairfax County is hosting the World Police & Fire Games (WPFG) from June 26 through July 5. 12,000 professional, public safety athletes from 70 countries will be competing in 60+ sports to qualify for over 1,600 medal events. The WPFG headquarters will be at the Reston Town Center. All events are open and free to the public. Opening ceremonies will be held at RFK Stadium on June 26. Closing ceremonies will be held at Wolftrap on July 5.

Thirteen of the sports will take place on the Fairfax Campus at George Mason at various venues including the Field House, the Recreation Athletic Complex (RAC), Aquatics & Fitness Center (AFC), Concert Hall, George Mason Stadium, and West Campus Tennis Courts. Some participants and families will be staying in residence halls on campus.

The sports being held on campus are: Baseball, Basketball, Boxing, Bodybuilding, Martial Arts, Orienteering, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball, and Wrestling.

There will be some parking and traffic impacts around campus, particularly around the venues. The general parking areas on campus as well as Lot J will be open for event parking.

As well from June 27-July 5, there will be an Indian religious festival each day at the Patriot Center, with up to 3000 per day expected, mostly parking in Lots A,C,K, and L. The event will be from 3:30pm-8pm on June 27 and 9am-2:30pm on the other days.

The Patriots Village (PV) Lot will be closed to regular permit parking and will only be available to use by WPFG officials starting June 22.

The southern half of West Campus Lot closest to Braddock Road will be closed to serve as the bus depot for the WPFG. Shuttles will transport spectators and athletes arriving by bus to venues around campus.

Traffic on and around campus will be busier than normal during the WPFG. Similar to other large events on campus, avoiding the entrances off Braddock Road at Roanoke River Road and Nottoway River Lane and utilizing other entrances including Campus Drive and University Dr is advised. General Permit parking in Rappahannock River Deck is suggested to avoid event parking.
